Sen. Marlon Kimpson, Rep. Marvin Pendarvis, and Rep. Wendell Gilliard created the Charleston Together Initiative. A portion of the Initiative is focused on providing financial grants to nonprofit organizations to enhance community and race relations by providing resources to programs and organizations that work with African American and other underserved communities.

A community committee has been formed to review the grant applications. Awards will range from \$1,000 - \$5,000. The first grant cycle will take place in August 2020. Grant requests will be accepted between Wednesday, July 29 – Saturday, August 15 and notifications will be made by September 5.

### Eligibility

Applications are accepted from non-profits that:

- a.) serve people who live in Charleston County;
- b.) are recognized by the I.R.S. as a public charity, exempt from income tax with a 501(c)(3) designation under I.R.S. Code Section 509(a)(1);
- c.) are not a political or lobbying organization; and
- d.) do not discriminate on the basis of age, religion, sex, race, color, sexual orientation, national/ethnic origin or disability.

Grants will be given to organizations that are working to enhance community and race relations, and work with African-American and underserved communities. Preference will be given organizations that demonstrate potential for systemic change, reform, or long-range impact; leverage knowledge of unique local neighborhood/community dynamics and build upon trust-based relationships; or promote constructive dialogue, creative expression, public awareness, and/or positive interactions among diverse community members.
